
First Visit Information and Map

- 1. Your visit may take up to 2 hours depending on the complexity of your condition and the flow of emergency patients for the day.
- 2. Your eyes may be dilated which can make you very sensitive to sunlight and also blur your vision. You may wish to have a driver available.
- 3. Bring your eyeglasses and or contact lens boxes (the packaging that has the numbers on it) with you.



Directions:

We are in a new building on 419 across from the old county library and just west of the Cave Spring Post Office. If traveling from Salem, go past the Lewis Gale Medical Center on 419 and go 3 miles east towards Tanglewood Mall. We are before 221/Brambleton Ave. on the left just before the Post Office. Turn in at the Carter Bank next to the post office and follow the signs.

If traveling from Roanoke and points to the east, turn onto 419 at Tanglewood Mall and go 2.5 miles west towards Salem. After you pass through the 221/Brambleton Ave. intersection, proceed just past the Post Office, turn in at the Carter Bank and proceed to the front of our building.
